

Golfer Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct establishes clear and acceptable behavioral expectations for all golfers at the Mooresville Golf Club (MGC). It is not intended to restrict the rights of anyone but to ensure that all golfers are treated the same while at the MGC. Upon payment of MGC membership or other golfing fees, players give their consent to abide by this Code of Conduct.

As a MGC golfer, you are expected to:

- Follow all posted rules and policies of the golf course
- Respect the golf course, golf carts, facilities, staff and other golfers
- Conduct yourself in a sportsmanlike manner, including refraining from profane language, gestures, insults or other such misbehavior
- Abstain from verbally or physically threatening or slandering others, either personally or through social media
- Abide by all state and local laws and regulations
- Report any unusual or inappropriate behavior to the management staff
- Not engage in any form of discrimination or harassment
- Do your part to make golfing at the MGC a pleasant experience for everyone by following standard golf course etiquette

Golfers who violate this Code of Conduct will be asked by the MGC management staff to correct their behavior. If golfers continue to disobey the Code of Conduct, the Town of Mooresville may ban individuals from the MGC and revoke MGC membership without refund, if applicable.
