Golf Course Rules

- All players must pay for all golf fees and check in before their scheduled tee times
- Each player must have their own set of clubs, unless otherwise approved by MGC staff
- Dress Code – All golfers must wear appropriate golf attire (cut-off jeans, t-shirts, shirts with profanity, tank tops, halter-style tops, racerback tops, plunging necklines, midriff-baring tops, excessively short skirts and shorts, and swimwear are not permitted)
- Every golfer is liable for any and all damages caused while playing golf
- Five-somes are not permitted on the golf course unless permitted by MGC staff
- All players are required to abide by the daily cart rules which are posted at the pro shop counter and on the GPS screens in the golf carts
- Personal coolers are not permitted on the golf course at any time
- Driving range bags/buckets are to be left on the driving range or brought back to the pro shop staff
- All players are required to follow the driving range hitting location (grass or mats only)
- Range plan members are not permitted to share golf balls with any other player
- All players need permission from the pro shop staff before starting on any hole except #1
- All golf cart keys are to be given out by the pro shop staff, and left in the retuning golf cart
- MGC requires a 4 hour and 15 minute pace of play for 18-holes, and 2 hours and 10 minutes for 9-holes
- All players are asked to fix all ball marks on the greens
- All players are asked to fill their divots in the fairway only with the sand provided by MGC
- All players operating a golf cart must have a valid driver's license, and a max of two players may ride in a golf cart
- Walking is not permitted before 12:00pm on Weekends/Holidays
- Each tee time is designed for four players, therefore MGC will pair up accordingly
- Starters and rangers have the authority to enforce pace of play and all course rules
